

2020 MASSACHUSETTS BOWLING ASSOCIATION LADIES' & MEN'S OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This is an OPEN tournament for ANY BOWLER from ANY CENTER (including non-MBA) who is at least 17 years of age as of the first day of this tournament.
2. Youth bowlers who enter this tournament may not enter the 2020 MBA State Youth Championships.
3. **AVERAGE CARD: NO FEE. All bowlers who enter this tournament must fill out and submit an MBA Average Request Card.** There is no fee for Open bowlers unless you enter a Handicap Event. **MBA Bowlers** must have your card completely filled out and signed by your league secretary **and** home center in order to be eligible for additional MBA prizes in this event. For all NON-MBA bowlers, the Average Request Card is for contact information only.
4. Entry form must be filled out completely and mailed to Metro Bowl, Peabody along with the entry fee. Make checks payable to "Metro Bowl". You may enter at any time, but there will be no shifts beyond May 9th at noon. Proof of proper entry is the responsibility of the bowler. In case of default for any reason, entry fee will not be refunded.
5. **All Events** must be entered before your first ball is thrown. This is a 15-string event. The All Events male and female winners will be the bowlers with the highest 15-string total of the three events: Singles – 5 strings, Doubles – 5 strings & Teams – 5 strings.
6. This is a scratch tournament. No handicaps will be given and there are no average limitations.
7. Cash prizes will be paid 1 for each 6 entries, rounded up. (ex: 9 entries = 2 prizes). Both men and women's divisions will be run concurrently and each will have their own separate prize pools. In case of ties, cash prizes will be divided equally. All notices and prize money will be forwarded to the first person listed with a legible mailing address on the entry form. Prize pools are determined by the number of entries
8. You will be required to submit a W9 if your total prize money is \$600 or more.
9. All ICBA rules will govern tournament play. All decisions of the tournament director will be final. Incomplete game(s) – score stands at time of default. Non-distribution of prize money will result in suspension from further MBA Tournaments.
10. The tournament director reserves the right to add and delete from the schedule as necessary. No shift will be added after the last posted shift.
11. The MBA Bowler with the highest All Events Total (not necessarily the All Events winner) will represent the MBA at the ICBA Rolloff in the Fall and could be eligible for additional prize money.
12. **FOR MBA ALL EVENTS BOWLERS ONLY:** Based on a minimum of 10 MBA bowlers, we will add up to \$500 for the bowler with the highest All Events Total amongst all other MBA A/E bowlers. Non MBA bowlers are not eligible for the ICBA Rolloff or the additional prize money.
